



# PROTECT YOUR LIVESTOCK FROM NEW WORLD SCREWORM

## WHAT YOU CAN DO NOW



Regularly inspect livestock and pets for signs of NWS, such as fly larvae in wounds or head shaking/irritability



Treat umbilical cords and wounds promptly with an approved insecticide



Contact a vet for care and lab testing if you see an infested wound

Three dark stripes along the back

Orange eyes

Same (or slightly larger) size as a common housefly

Metallic blue or green body

Keep an eye out for adult screwworm flies

## WHAT YOU CAN DO IF THERE IS AN OUTBREAK



Report a suspected NWS immediately to your state animal health office and APHIS office



Inspect vehicle for flies if you are leaving a NWS-infested area



Postpone/avoid procedures that create wounds
